

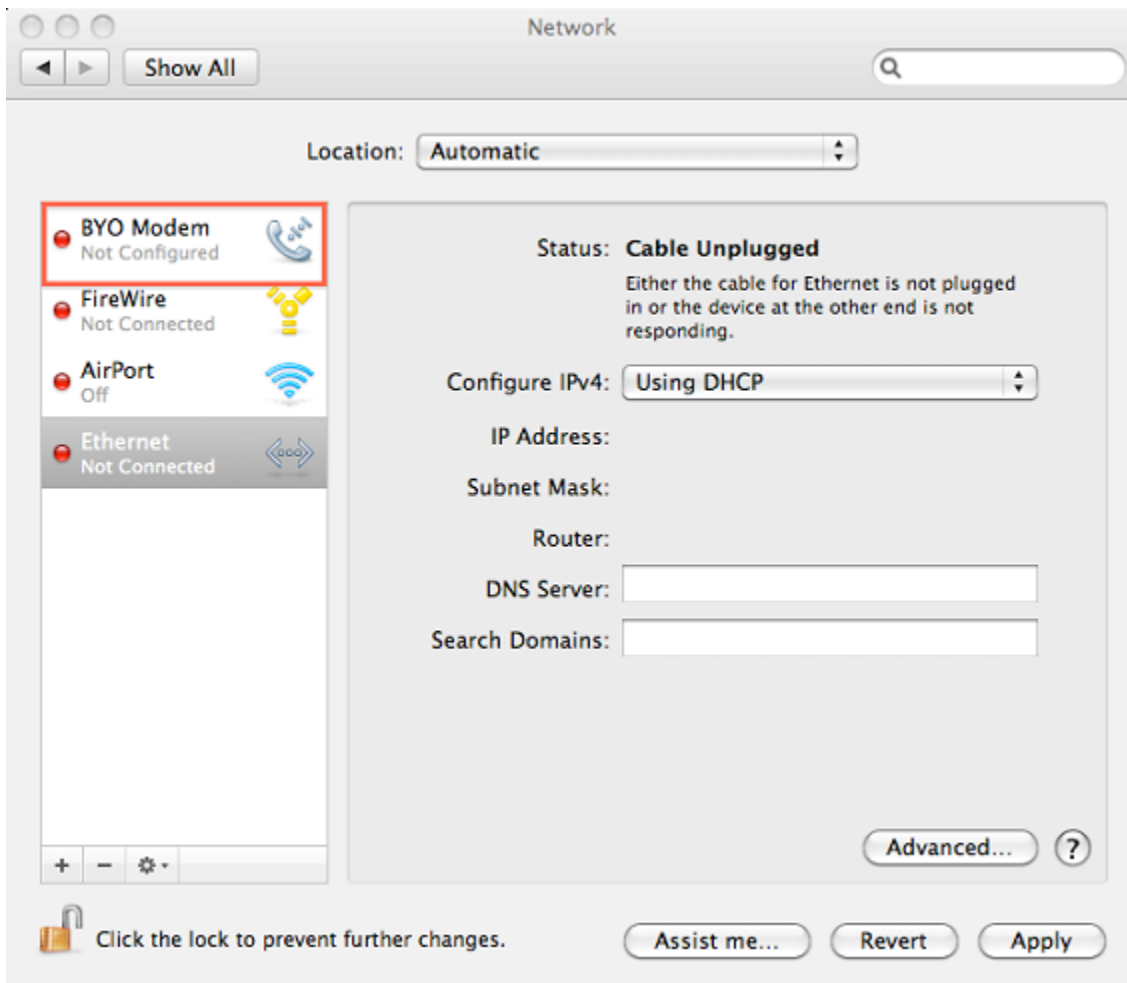

For Mac OSX 10.5.x (Leopard) & 10.6.x (Snow Leopard)

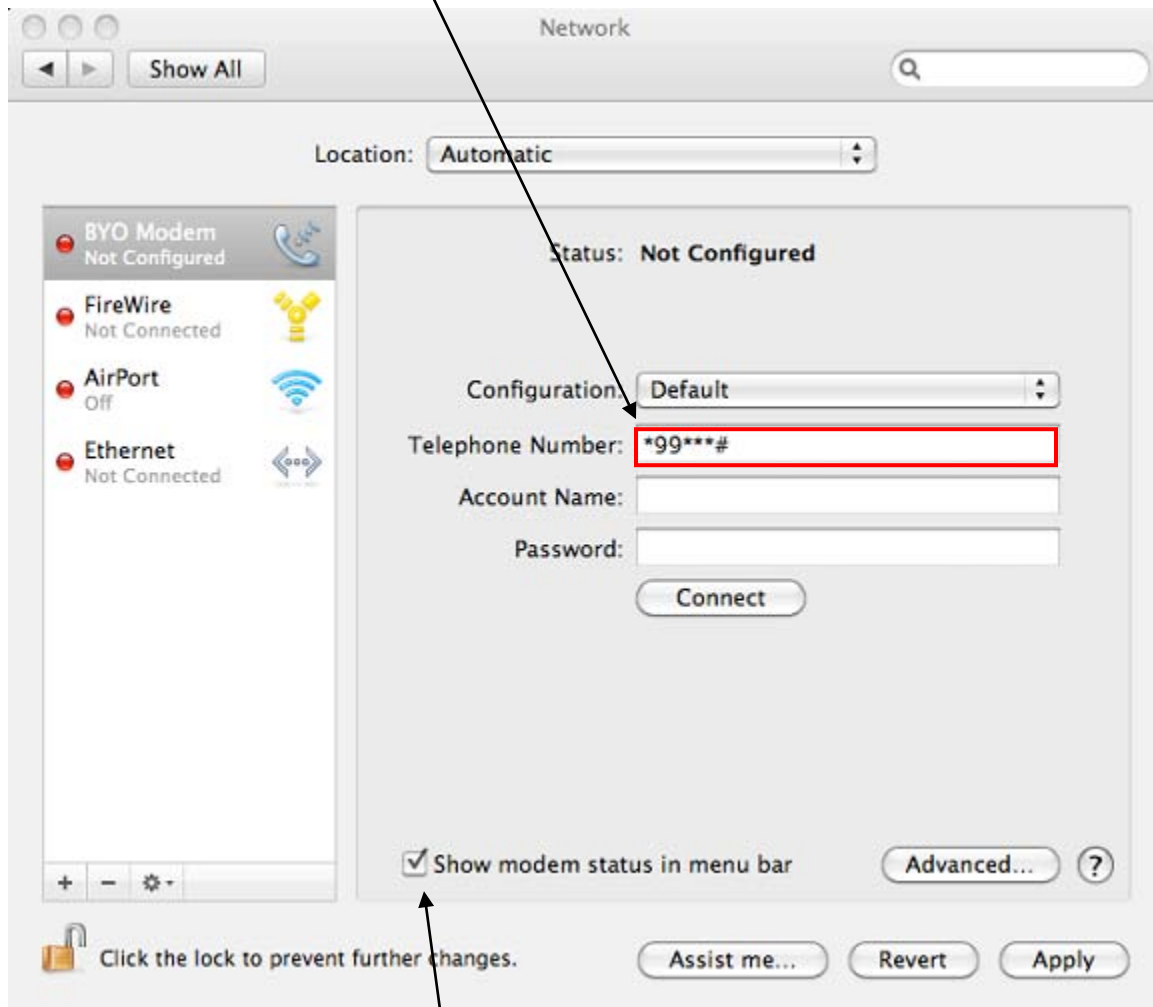
1. Go to **Apple Menu>Preferences>Network**



2. **Choose your USB Modem.** Here we will select BYO Modem *(Your modem will be named anything you want it to be, ours is BYO for demonstration)
3. A configuration will now open

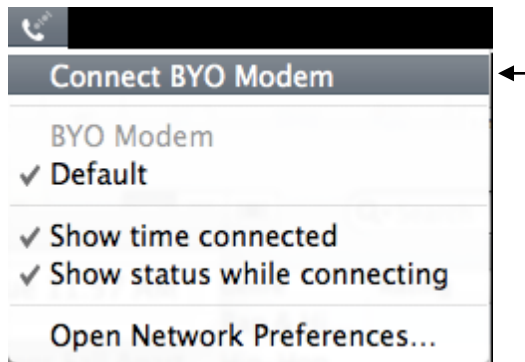


4. Now enter ***99#** or ***99***1#** in the 'Telephone number' field.



5. Then select **'Show modem status in menu bar'** so a shortcut is placed on your Finder menu.
6. Do not enter anything else and click **'Apply'**

7. Selecting Apply will save your settings and you will now be able to connect to the Internet. By selecting the **“Show modem status in menu bar”** you have set that a shortcut will be placed on your Finder menu



8. Once done, you have successfully created an internet connection!
